A pregnancy related disease characterized by high blood pressure and protein in urine which can be fatal to both the mother and fetus



You can get Preeclampsia if you have,



- · Chronic high blood pressure
- · Family history of Preeclampsia
- · Maternal age >35
- · Carrying more than 1 baby
- · IVF, IUI etc.

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS



High blood pressure
>140/90 mmHg of systolic
and diestolic blood pressure



Proteinuria



Swelling of body parts



Blurred Vision



Vomiting



Kidney Failure

Risks to Mother

- Seizure
- · Heart Disease

- · Premature birth
- · Low birth weight
